

Sustainability policy – on location

PAA believes that in order to provide a comfortable working environment, it is necessary for sustainability. To do this, we aim to ensure the wise use of all resources within a framework in which environmental, social and economic factors are integrated and considered. Our policy is to provide an environment, where we can act together to create a healthy, safe place.

We believe that it is important for development to meet the needs of the present day, without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs. This means we are aiming to improve the quality of life for people today, as well as considering those who will live after us.

We also feel that any person should be able to contribute to any decision which might affect their quality of life or their environment. PAA maintains that it is particularly important to develop, providing for the needs of the entire working community, without exclusion or disadvantage to any group. In addition to these factors, we try to develop the capacities of our employees to promote an understanding of the principles of sustainability.

PAA will carry out its tasks on location, with an active regard for its surroundings in mind, and a positive approach to the care and conservation of flora and fauna, where its tasks interfere with such habitats. Crew are encouraged to make themselves completely aware of any potential damage to premises or location that their task might inflict, and either to obviate this or with the approval of the venue manager, minimise such potential damage.

We encourage research and learning into a sustainable environment, while periodically updating our policy.
